 Custom Mask
 Image: Custom Mask allows you to create your own format to tailor the way information is displayed on the finished form. This function is especially useful for displaying codes, constructing special currency formats and incorporating text within variable data.

To create a custom mask:

Create a new variable text object or edit an existing variable text object.
On the Link to field dialog box, select Custom from the Mask as menu.

- Create a new variable text object or edit an existing variable text object.
 On the Link to field dialog box, select Custom from the Mask as menu.

In the Mask text box, highlight the area where the leading zeros or spaces will appear. Click on the Left button. The highlighted area will change color. The purple highlight indicates the start of the suppression and the blue highlight indicates where left suppression will occur.



- To delete the suppression, highlight the area of the suppression mask you wish to delete and click the **Delete** button.
 Check the **Suppress spaces only** if you want to suppress only leading or trailing spaces from the data field.
 Check the **Space replace suppressed character** if you want to replace suppressed characters with spaces. This is useful if you want to keep alignment as is as is.

In the following example we remove a trailing space from the company name variable.
