Use pre-defined variable

To use a pre-defined variable:

- Choose Text from the Draw menu or click the Text tool button on the toolbar.
 Click and drag diagonally to add the new text frame.
 release the mouse button and the Text dialog box will open.
 On the Definition tab, enter sample text into the text box. When creating variable text objects it is best to make the sample text the maximum possible length of the field outer the data.
- length of the field extracted from the data.To link all the sample text to the variable, click on the Link all... button.
