Evaluation Order of Entries



It is most unusual to have more than one entry in a Repaginator file, however has been allowed for. If your repaginator file contains more than one entry, you can modify the order in which those entries are tested. Entries with the most precise rules on the header should be placed at the top of the list.

To modify the order of entries:

- $\bullet\,$ Select $\mbox{Order of entries}$ from the \mbox{Edit} menu. The $\mbox{Evaluation order}$ dialog box opens.
 Select an entry and click an ordering button to move the entry either up or down in
- the Order list.
 - Highest move the entry to the top of the list.
 Up move the entry up one place in the list.
- Down move the entry down one place in the list.
 Lowest move the entry to the bottom of the list.
 Click **OK** to save the changes.
