Defining Fields

Before starting to design the layout of a Print Line mode form, you can define the fields or records that belong to each element of the form. Each record can also be defined as the variable text or barcode object is created.

After creating the variables, you need to **map the variables** to the corresponding fields in the loaded sample data.

Create Record Field

To define the record variables on each page element:

- Select the appropriate element on the Go menu.
- Select **Properties of...** from the **Define** menu.
- On the Records tab, click on the New... button to add a new record.
